Notes to the Abbreviated Accounts for the period ended 31 May 2014

1 Accounting Policies

Basis of measurement and preparation of accounts

The accounts have been prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities effective April 2008.

These financial statements have been prepared on a going concern basis. The company is dependent on the support of the director, who has loan accounts totalling £22,463 included in creditors due within one year and £45,000 due after one year. The director has given written confirmation that he does not intend to withdraw the existing funds within the next twelve months. The going concern basis is therefore believed to be appropriate and the financial statements do not include any adjustments that might result from a withdrawal of funds.

Turnover policy

Turnover represents amounts receivable for goods and services net of VAT and trade discounts.

Tangible assets depreciation policy

Tangible fixed assets are stated at cost less depreciation. Depreciation is provided at rates calculated to write off the cost less estimated residual value of each asset over its expected useful life, as follows: Land and buildings leasehold no depreciation charged, plant and machinery at 25% reducing balance basis.

Intangible assets amortisation policy

Acquired goodwill is written off in equal annual instalments over its estimated useful economic life of twenty years.
